	<p><b>Disturbed sensory perception(visual)</b>  <b>Related factors:</b>                      Altered sensory perception                      Detached retina  <b>Symptoms / Risk factors:</b>                      progressive loss of visual field  <b>Outcome / Goal:</b>                      Maintain current visual field without further loss</p>		<p><b>Communication Enhancement: Visual Deficit</b>                      Ascertain type and degree of visual loss.                      Assist with administration of medications, as indicated                      Do not make unnecessary changes in the environment                      Elevate head of bed for hospitalized client as indicated                      Instruct patient to relax and rest                      Prepare for surgical intervention as indicated                      Provide adequate lighting                      Provide sedation and analgesics, as necessary                      Recommend use of visual aids when appropriate                      Remove environmental barriers to ensure safety</p> <p><b>Surgical Preparation</b>                      Administer preoperative medications as ordered                      Describe any preoperative medications, the effects these will have on the patient                      Describe the preoperative routines                      Determine the patient's expectations of the surgery                      Instruct the patient not to touch the eyes to avoid contamination                      Instruct the patient to remain quiet in prescribed (dependent) position                      Patch both eyes                      Provide time for the patient to ask questions and discuss concerns                      Wash the patient's face with antibacterial solution</p>
