	<p>Dysfunctional grieving Related factors: Loss Difficult situation Symptoms / Risk factors: Depression Decreased self-esteem Outcome / Goal: Identify and express feelings appropriately Looking toward and planning for the future, one day at a time</p>		<p>Grief Work Facilitation Determine degree of insight in the present situation Provide quiet and privacy when needed or requested. Offer feedback regarding the patient's expressed feelings.</p>	
	<p>Deficient knowledge: Preoperative Related factors: Unfamiliarity with information resources Symptoms / Risk factors: Increase in anxiety level Multiple questions Outcome / Goal: Patient verbalize understanding of procedure</p>		<p>Teaching: Preoperative Describe the preoperative routines Provide time for the patient to ask questions and discuss concerns</p>	
	<p>Acute pain Related factors: Evac Symptoms / Risk factors: Crampy pain Facial mask Verbal or coded report Outcome / Goal: Patient appears relaxed and comfortable Patient verbalizes relief of pain</p>		<p>Pain Management Assess cause of pain Administer medication as prescribed Obs. pain (effectiveness of medication)</p>	
	<p>Risk for deficient fluid volume Related factors: Evac Symptoms / Risk factors: Uterine Bleeding Outcome / Goal: Normal vital signs No sign of bleeding from Uterus</p>		<p>Vital Signs Monitoring Obs sign of bleeding Monitor patient's vital signs 5 minutes when in postop care unit Check the tone of the fundus (should be firm)</p>	
	<p>Deficient knowledge: Postoperative Related factors: Lack of previous experience with surgery Symptoms / Risk factors: Indications of concern, request for information Outcome / Goal: Patient verbalizes understanding of need for follow-up care</p>		<p>Discharge Planning Teach patient recognize signs of hemorrhage and when to report Discharge planned _____</p>
