	<p><b>Impaired parenting</b></p> <p><b>Related factors:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Family conflicts</li> <li>Infant or Child</li> <li>Knowledge</li> <li>Physiological</li> <li>Psychological</li> <li>Social</li> <li>Difficult labor and/or delivery</li> <li>Disability</li> <li>Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder</li> <li>Poor home environment</li> <li>Young age, especially adolescent</li> </ul> <p><b>Symptoms / Risk factors:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Ill-defined family rules, functions, and roles</li> <li>Depression</li> <li>Low self-esteem</li> </ul> <p><b>Outcome / Goal:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Recognize and resolve conflict appropriately</li> </ul>		<p><b>Parenting Promotion</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Asses parents understanding and expectations of infants future</li> <li>Assist parents to gain a realistic view of capabilities of infant</li> <li>Encourage and allow expression of feelings by individuals</li> <li>Identify patterns of interaction</li> <li>Inform parents of neonate's immediate needs</li> <li>Place newborn in mother's/father's arms as possible</li> <li>Provide appropriate information in the event of unanticipated complications</li> <li>Refer to family therapy groups</li> <li>Share information gained from initial physical assesment of infant</li> </ul>
